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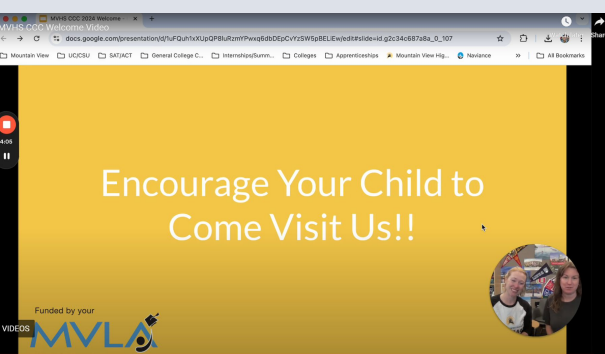

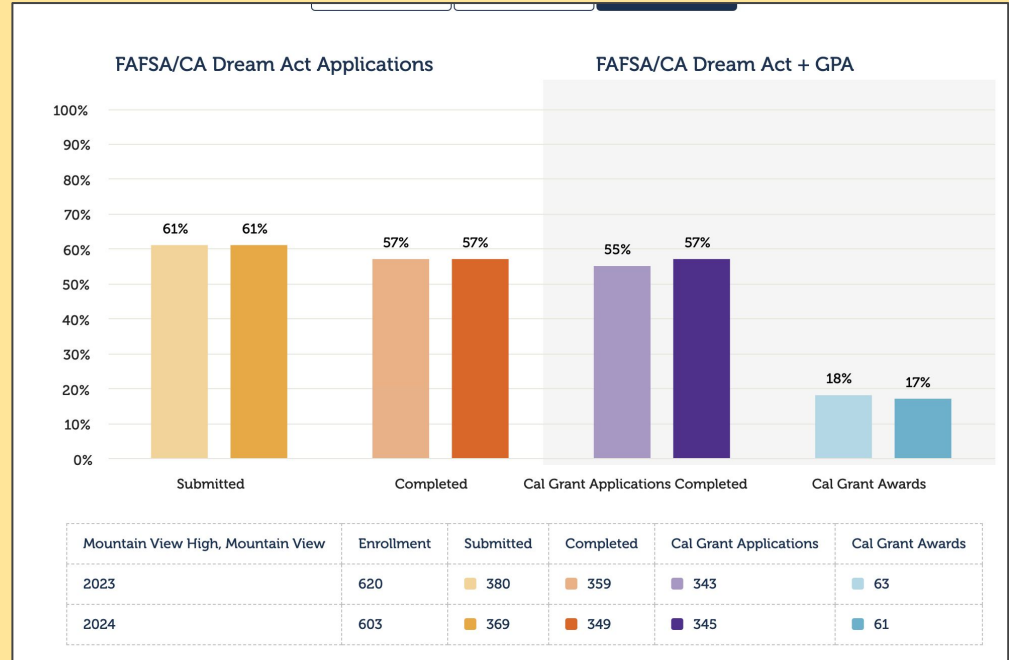

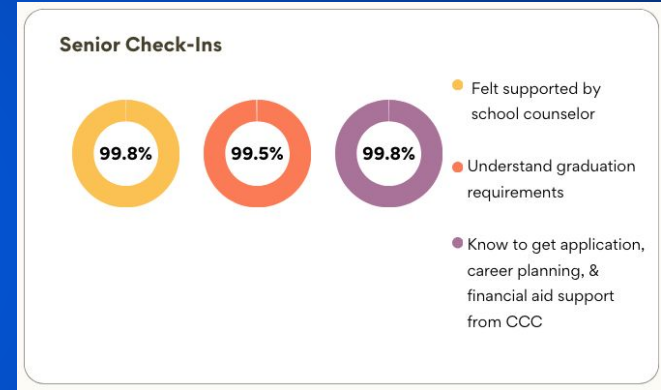
MVHS School Counseling

- Data
 - Number of students in **AVID that met UC a-g** requirements went from **81% to 86%**.
(5% increase)
 - **MVHS Latinx students** target group went from **graduating at 74% to 93%** from 2023 to 2024. **(9% increase in graduation rate)**
 - MVHS Latinx students target group went from **75% to 80% meeting UC a-g** from 2023 to 2024. **(5% increase in UC a-g)**
 - Students with one or more D or F went from **348 students to 253 students** from 2023 to 2024.
 - **(95 more students passing all classes with a C or better!)**
 - **(27% decrease in D's/F's!)**

LAHS School Counseling

Focus on data for 2024-2025:

- Process of interventions & attitude and skills of students
- 9th grade check-ins, 10th grade small groups, 12th grade check-ins
- Questions to determine whether or not students feel supported and know how/where to access school resources



LAHS School Counseling

- Progress on MTMDSS Professional Development Goals since 2022:
 - Hatching Results & ASCA
 - College visits and conferences
 - PD time used to share, learn, and collaborate on best practices for tiered systems of support
- Focus moving forward on refining Tier 2 & 3 supports
