During her research, she discovered the story of the endangered Franciscan Manzanita, which became her central metaphor and allowed her to weave her interests in botany and environmentalism into a layered work of creative nonfiction. When she recited the essay in class, its emotional power moved several audience members to tears (truly—I was one of them). This is just one of many transformative moments Nadine has helped create. In her quiet and genuine way, she brings kindness to every interaction—with both peers and teachers. She gives and receives feedback with grace, asks insightful questions, and is always eager to lend a hand. It's also worth noting that Nadine is only the second senior ever to create the Freestyle yearbook. Her excellence and deep care for our community shine through in everything she does.
