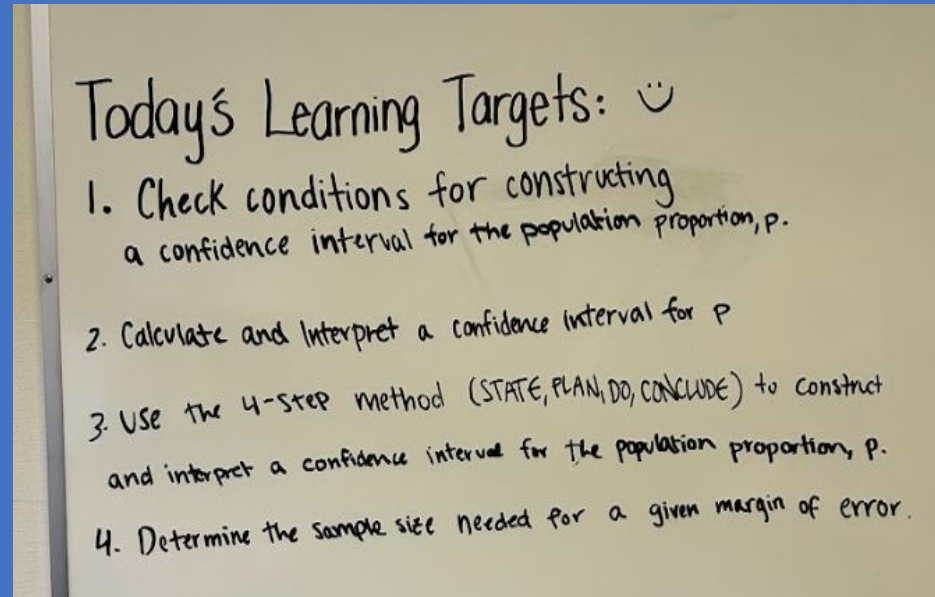

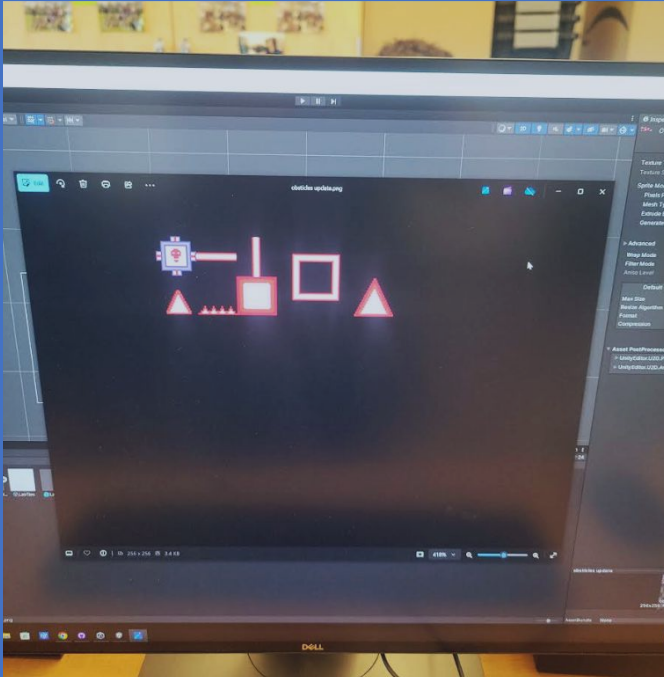

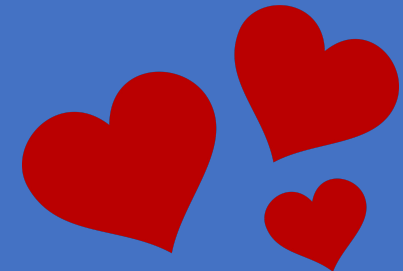
Student Volunteerism: Mountain View Youth Advisory Committee

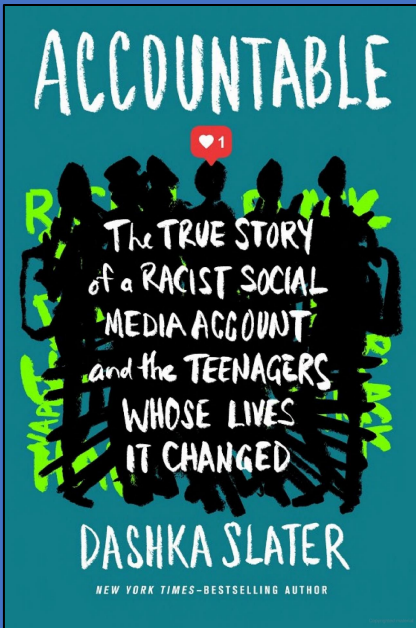

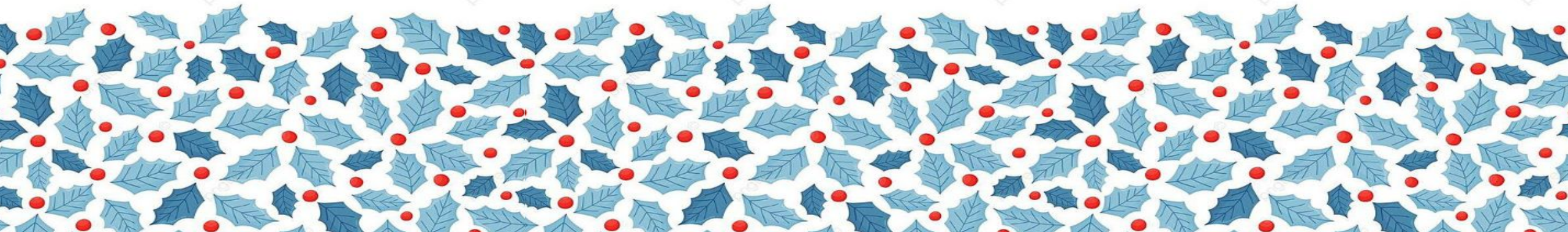
