



In surveying AVHS students over time, they agree that they:







College & Career Preparation

- -18 a-g approved courses now taught on campus
- -Extensive online honors/AP & elective/career-prep options
- -10,000+ instructional minutes annually *beyond minimum requirements*
- -14 hours annually of professional development specific to continuation high school and at-promise student population
- -College & Career Coordinator (part-time)

Proposal for an Alternative Program of Choice; a division of Alta Vista High School

Vista College & Career Prep:

A personalized high school experience characterized by academic rigor and career preparation

A Vista Prep Student Would:

-be on track for graduation, or aiming for early graduation;

-apply and enroll voluntarily;

-have completed a minimum of (1) semester at AVHS prior to acceptance;

-be enrolled in **college-prep coursework** across subjects;

-by senior year, be **bound for four-year college** (directly, or as community college transfer)

-participate in career training

Vista Prep creates:

-<u>structure for voluntary enrollment</u> for on-track and/or advanced students

-a <u>small, personalized high school experience</u> characterized by academic rigor and career preparation

-<u>academic distinction</u> for small number of students choosing to: 1) stay at AVHS while applying to four-year colleges; and/or 2) graduate early.

-advancement & recognition within AVHS

What would change structurally?

-AVHS will continue to increase in-seat college-prep course offerings

-We would reformat transcript notation, similar to Foothill Middle College Program notation

-We would continue to grow toward CTE
